



Strathmore Summer Parent Survey (Academic Year 2021-2022)

Key summary statements:

59 families completed the survey – Thank you!

Proportionately, the most families who contributed were our Grey Court Campus families.

97% said their children were happy at Strathmore. 0 disagreed and 2 families did not know.

98% said their children are safe at Strathmore. 0 disagreed and 1 family did not know.

80% said their children are making good progress. 1 disagreed. 11 don't know. **88%** feel involved in their child's education, 7% do not and 5% don't know. Please come to parents evening and the Annual Reviews to find out more 😊.

95% said their children's achievements were celebrated. 3% disagree. 1 family don't know.

98% said they feel comfortable about approaching Strathmore School staff with a question, problem or complaint. 1 family does not.

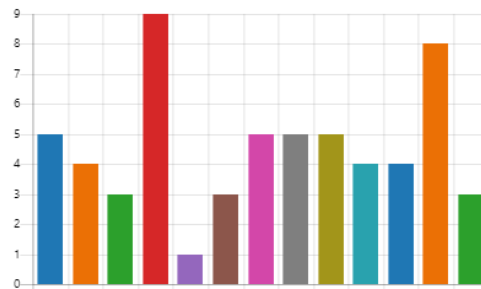

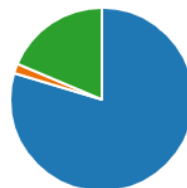

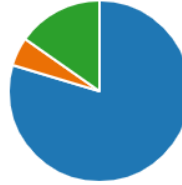

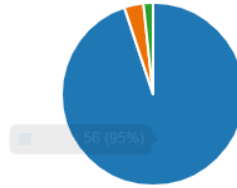
